






Diagnostic Order


- Diagnostic Order allows us to order any diagnostic order and upload result as well.
- Path: “**Patient Hub>>Diagnostic Order**” [Select Patient First]



- After Clicking on diagnostic order, you will get the below screen



1. Enter the Order Title.
2. Select the diagnostic group.
3. Search and Select for the studies from the selected group.
4. Search and Select the diagnosis code.
5. Enter Order Date.
6. Enter Lab Note if any.
7. Click on ‘**Cancel**’ to cancel the added details.
8. Click on ‘**Next**’ to go to the next screen as shown below

19. Click on '**Complete As**' and it will give you two more options for taking a print of the Order or the Fax.
20. Click on '**Save**' to save the order.
21. Click on '**Save & Send**' to save and send the Diagnostic Order.



26. Click on '**Order Template Settings**' to create a new template and you will get below screen as follows




- A. Enter the Template Name.



1. Search and Select the Patient.
2. Search and Select the Provider.
3. Select the Status.
4. Select "Sign/Unsign" status of the Order.
5. Select From Date.



6. Select To Date.
7. Click on '**Search**' to search for the selected details.
8. Click on '**Clear**' to clear the filtered data.
9. Select the checkbox and click on '**Sign Off**' to sign off the diagnostic orders.
10. Select the checkbox and click on '**Send**' to change the status to "Sent to Radiology".
11. Click on "Patient Name" and you will be redirected on Patient Chart.
12. Click on "Export To Excel" to get the displayed details in Excel format.
13. Click on '**Order Title**' to open the diagnostic order popup and you can even upload result.
14. Click on  icon to view the Diagnostic Result.
15. Click on  icon to add the comment against the Result.
16. Click on  icon to delete the diagnostic order.
